## ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is ordering Janet Parks to show cause why the Commission should not dismiss this case for failure to prosecute and for failure to comply with Commission orders.

By order dated July 13, 2011, the Commission directed Ms. Parks to file a status report, stating whether she is prepared for hearing on her complaint, by the last business day of each month. October 31, 2011, is the date of Ms. Parks' last filing, and the Commission reminded Ms. Parks of her filing requirement by order dated November 1, 2011. Commission regulations provide that a complaint is subject to dismissal for failure to comply with a Commission order<sup>1</sup> and for inactivity.<sup>2</sup>

Therefore, the Commission will order Ms. Parks to file a response to this order showing cause why her complaint should not be dismissed.
