NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

Issue Date: May 18, 2006

On April 13, 2006, the Commission issued a Suspension Order and Notice in which it set an intervention deadline of May 9, 2006. Hannibal Regional Hospital filed a timely application to intervene. The applicant states that it relies on Atmos for transportation and delivery of its natural gas needs and that, as a transportation customer, its interest in this case differs from that of the general public. The applicant further states that its proposed intervention would serve the public interest by representing interests that would not otherwise be represented, thereby permitting the development of a more complete record regarding this rate application.

Hannibal Regional Hospital advises that it does not yet have sufficient information to take a position regarding Atmos's application, but reserves the right to take a position on all issues that may affect it.

At the prehearing conference on May 17, 2006, the parties were given an opportunity to object and no objection was made. Thus, the Regulatory Law Judge found that the application to intervene substantially complied with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.075. The Judge also found that Hannibal Regional Hospital has an interest in this

proceeding different from that of the general public. The Regulatory Law Judge, therefore, granted the application to intervene.

The Commission's Data Center shall therefore add Hannibal Regional Hospital as a party to this case.
