ORDER SCHEDULING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE
AND DIRECTING FILING

On September 20, 2007, Missouri Gas Utility, Inc., filed its response to the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission's recommendation. In its response, MGU objected to a \$12,482 disallowance proposed by Staff for the interest charges incurred by MGU for funds borrowed to pay for gas placed into storage as part of the Company's hedging strategy. MGU also disagrees with Staff's reporting requirements and requested that it be allowed until December 1, 2007, to provide its 2007/2008 Hedging Plan and an internal Hedging and Gas Supply document to Staff. Therefore, the Commission will schedule a procedural conference to afford the parties the opportunity to discuss and possibly resolve the issues presented, and to discuss the procedural schedule to be followed in this matter. The Commission will also set a date for the filing of a proposed procedural schedule to ensure that this case progresses expeditiously.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A procedural conference shall be held on October 9, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, a

2. The parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than October 16, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on September 25, 2007.
