THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission gives notice that it shall hold local public hearings. A question-and-answer session will be held thirty minutes before commencing each hearing.

All noon hearings shall convert to listening posts in the event the hearing lasts less than two hours, and the Commission shall remain on-site to take public comments until 2:00 p.m. at those locations. All hearings beginning at 6:00 p.m. shall conclude after all members of the public present at the hearing have had an opportunity to give comments.

4. None of the hearings will be video-conferenced or webcast. All hearings, including the question and answer sessions, shall be video-recorded by the Commission's Information Officer.

5. No later than June 1, 2010, Atmos Energy Corporation shall mail a notice of these hearings to its customers consistent with this order, said notice being approved by the Staff of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel before it is mailed. Staff shall file a copy of the notice with the Commission.

Customers wishing to make written comments or secure additional information may contact the Office of the Public Counsel, Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, telephone (573) 751-4857. Comments may also be registered in this case using the Internet Electronic Filing System at <http://psces/mpsc/>. Use the link to the Public Comment section and fill in all required fields on the comment page.

7. These local public hearings shall be held in facilities that meet the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. 8. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commissions of all counties in Atmos Energy Corporation's service area.

9. The Public Information Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall make notice of this order available to members of the General Assembly representing the residents in Atmos Energy Corporation's service area, and to the news media serving the residents of that service area.

10. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
