- Q. Please state your name and business address.
- A. My name is Kenneth M. Beerup Jr., and my business address is 720 Olive St., St.
- 3 Louis, Missouri, 63101.
- 4 Q. What is your present position?
- 5 A. I am the Manager, General Accounting.
- 6 Q. Please state how long you have held your position and briefly describe your
- 7 responsibilities.
- 8 A. I was promoted to my present position in January, 2001. In this position, I am
- 9 responsible for the processing of payments to our suppliers and maintaining
- 10 various records.
- 11 Q. What is your educational background?
- 12 A. I graduated from Western Illinois University in 1993 with the degree of Bachelor
- of Business, majoring in finance. In 1994, I received a Master's Degree in
- Business Administration from Saint Louis University.
- 15 Q. Will you briefly describe your experience with the Company prior to becoming
- Manager, General Accounting?
- 17 A. I joined Laclede in February, 1995, as a Budget Analyst in the Budget
- Department. In November, 1996, I was promoted to Senior Budget Analyst. In
- January, 1997, I was assigned to a project team responsible for assisting the
- 20 Information Systems Department in implementing a new General Ledger software

2		Planning Department. I acted in that capacity until being promoted to my current
3		position.
4	Q.	Have you previously filed testimony before this Commission?
5	A.	No, I have not.
6		PURPOSE OF TESTIMONY
7	Q.	What is the purpose of your testimony?
8	A.	I am sponsoring certain components of the Company's calculation of cash
9		working capital as referred to in the testimony of Company witness G. W. Buck.
10	Q.	Please list the schedules you are sponsoring.
11	A.	Schedule 9 of Section A, SUMMARY OF CASH WORKING CAPITAL was
12		prepared by me or under my supervision.
13		EXPENSE LAG - CASH WORKING CAPITAL
14	Q.	Please discuss Schedule 9 of Section A.
15	A.	Schedule 9 is a summary schedule showing the computation of cash working
16		capital required for payment of operating expenses. Various major expense
17		categories were studied in GR-96-193 to determine the length of lag time that is
18		supplied by the Company's vendors and employees. This expense lag time is
19		subtracted from the overall revenue lag time, from Company Witness G. W.
20		Buck's Schedule 8, and the resultant net lag (or net lead) time is multiplied by
21		daily expense to derive the average cash working capital required from (or
22		available to) the Company's investors for each category. These computations are

1		combined to determine the cash working capital required from the Company's
2		investors. This total, as shown at the bottom of Schedule 9, is the amount of Cash
3		Working Capital Mr. Buck is sponsoring for inclusion in rate base.
4	Q.	What time period was utilized to calculate the expense lag times used in Schedule
5		9?
	٨	Since there has been no significant change in the manner in which the Company

Since there has been no significant change in the manner in which the Company processes payments, the expense lag times used in Schedule 9 are consistent with those that were calculated in Case No. GR-96-193 with the following exceptions:

(1) the twelve-month period ended February 28, 2001 was used to calculate gas cost payment time; (2) the payment lag time associated with payroll and related items (401(k), payroll taxes and withholdings) was updated to reflect a projected August 1, 2001 change to a bi-weekly payroll payment for the Laclede division Contract employees; and (3) the twelve-month period ended February 28, 2001 was used to calculate short-term interest expense payment lag time.

Q. Does this complete your testimony?
