## KCP&L GREATER MISSOURI OPERATIONS COMPANY'S RESPONSE TO COMMISSION'S ORDER

**COMES NOW** KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (hereinafter "GMO" or "Company"), and in response to the Order Temporarily Suspending Requirement to File Surrebuttal Testimony issued on April 9, 2012, respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On April 9, 2012 the Office of Public Counsel, WalMart Stores, Inc. and Sam's East, Inc., the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, Sedalia Industrial Energy Users Association, and AG Processing, Inc. filed a Joint Response in Opposition to Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule and Motion for Expedited Treatment.
- 2. On April 9, 2012, the Commission issued its Order in which it ordered that any party who wishes to respond shall do so no later than noon on April 10, 2012.
- 3. GMO is very interested in pursuing settlement negotiations. The April 4, 2012 comprehensive settlement proposal that was sent to the Company requested a response by April 6, 2012. Since the response date coincided with a Company holiday, it was not possible to perform the work necessary to create a counter proposal in such a short amount of time. Instead, GMO's April 5, 2012, response to the comprehensive settlement proposal listed a number of items that were not acceptable to the Company, asked that the parties modify the settlement proposal in light of these issues and requested further negotiations on specific dates.
- 4. The Company is prepared to work toward a settlement during upcoming negotiations and will present a counter proposal to the parties before those negotiations.

**WHEREFORE**, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company requests that the Commission modify the procedural schedule as requested in its motion.
