**STAFF'S MARCH 30, 2018 STATUS REPORT**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through undersigned Staff counsel, and states as follows for the *Staff's March 30, 2018, Status Report*:

1. The Staff previously reported that on December 28, 2017, the Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel") received by e-mail from Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. ("SNGMo") a further draft of the CAM and a spreadsheet showing responses to Staff questions and comments which appeared in the redlined CAM that the Staff had e-mailed to SNGMo on September 29, 2017.

2. On January 31, 2018, the Staff e-mailed to Counsel for SNGMo and Public Counsel a Staff "redlining" of the SNGMo CAM draft document received from SNGMo on December 28, 2017. Among other things, the Staff's redlined version of SNGMo's December 28, 2017, document includes Staff comments. The Staff in its January 31, 2018, e-mail to SNGMo and Public Counsel suggested that the parties meet in person and/or by conference call to discuss the different proposed versions and comments.

3. The Staff also previously reported that a staff member for Summit Utilities, Inc. ("SUI")<sup>1</sup> had explained to a member of the Staff that SUI / SNGMo personnel had

not been able to devote time to the Staff's CAM document because SUI / SNGMo had been addressing, for example, information requests from the MoPSC and other state public service commissions regarding the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017.

4. Counsel for SNGMo has recently advised counsel for the Staff that SNGMo is available for an in-person meeting with the Staff and Public Counsel on April 18, 2018. SNGMo, the Staff and Public Counsel have agreed to meet on April 18, 2018 beginning at 9:30 a.m. Conference Room 210 in the Governor Office Building in Jefferson City has been reserved for the meeting.

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff submits its *March 30, 2018, Status Report*.
