1 JUDGE HATCHER: Let's go on the record. 2 First, I would like to ask everyone to please mute themselves unless speaking. That does cut down on our 3 noise level and also prevent any audio feedback. 4 Today is June 25th, 2021. The Missouri 5 Public Service Commission has set this time for a 6 7 local public hearing to give members of the public a 8 chance to comment about Spire's application. The Case 9 Number is GR-2021-0108 and that is captioned In the Matter of Spire Missouri, Inc., doing business as 10 Spire's, Request for Authority to Implement a General 11 12 Rate Increase for Natural Gas Service Provided in the Company's Missouri Service Areas. 13

The Missouri Public Service Commission regulates the rates charged by public utility companies in Missouri to ensure that those rates is just and reasonable. The Commission also regulates the quality of service and safety of the operations of public utilities.

The Commission is made up of five Commissioners. Those Commissioners are appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. The Public Service Commission employs a staff of engineers, accountants, attorneys, financial analysts and other specialists in the field of utility regulation.

3	hearing. With me today are Commissioners Coleman and
4	Commissioner Kolkmeyer. This is an official hearing
5	of the Missouri Public Service Commission and the
б	statements and testimony of the witnesses will be

8	oath.
9	The Commission has not made any decisions
10	in this case and cannot answer any questions today
11	because they have to remain impartial until after all
12	of the evidence is presented.
