ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO CONTINUE INVESTIGATION

Effective Date: November 6, 2013

On February 27, 2013, the Commission directed its Staff to investigate a natural gas explosion that occurred on February 19, 2013 in Kansas City, Missouri. The Commission asked Staff to provide periodic updates during the course of its investigation. Staff filed its most recent Status Report on October 28.

Staff explains that it continues to investigate the cause of the explosion. Once that investigation is complete, Staff will file a Gas Incident Report to explain in detail the facts of the explosion and Staff's analysis, conclusions and recommendations. Staff expects to file the Gas Incident Report in December, 2013, and will file its next Status Report or the Gas Incident Report no later than December 31, 2013.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall continue to investigate the gas safety incident and shall file its next Status Report regarding its investigation or the Gas Incident Report no later than December 31, 2013.

2. This order shall be effective upon issuance.
