## STAFF'S MOTION TO ESTABLISH A CASE FOR INVESTIGATION OF A GAS SAFETY INCIDENT

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and hereby moves the Commission to establish a case for investigation of a gas safety incident, as follows:

- 1. The Missouri Public Service Commission has statutory responsibility to assure the health and safety of employees, customers, and the public served by natural gas corporations under Section 386.310 RSMo.
- 2. The cited section authorizes the Commission, after hearing or complaint, to order a utility to take appropriate steps to promote the safety of its employees, customers, and the general public.
- 3. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri is a "gas corporation" as defined in Section 386.020(18) RSMo and therefore subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- 4. A reportable incident occurred on Friday, November 27, 2015, in Louisiana, Missouri, an area served by Ameren Missouri. No injuries were reported and significant property damage occurred.
- 5. Staff's initial investigation indicates that natural gas was released from a natural gas service line. The escaping natural gas was ignited outside of a restaurant at

3404 Georgia Street in Louisiana, Missouri, at approximately 2:50 PM. The natural gas fire spread to the inside of the restaurant and the building was destroyed.

- 6. As a result of this incident, Staff recommends the Commission establish a case for purposes of receiving a report resulting from the investigation of the incident by the Commission's Safety Engineering Unit.
- 7. Staff further recommends that the Commission direct that the report, or a status report, be filed within 180 days of the date on which the case is established.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission establish a case for the purpose of receiving a report, or status report, as described herein.
