ORDER REGARDING CUSTOMER NOTICE

On March 13, 1998 a Request To Delay Distribution Of Commission Notice Regarding Elimination Of Community Optional Service was filed by Alltel Missouri, et. al. (Alltel)¹. None of the parties has filed a pleading in response to Alltel's motion. The Commission had originally ordered that Community Optional Service (COS) be eliminated on March 31. However, the Commission subsequently issued an order extending the elimination date and, as a result of that order, not all COS routes will be eliminated on the same date.

In response to Alltel's request the Commission has determined that a generic proposed notice (or notices) should be drafted by the parties. Such a notice should only require minimal changes from exchange to exchange to identify the name of the route and the specific date of termination. The parties may also propose a similar notice which incorporates notice of IntraLATA presubscription along with notice of the elimination of COS.

The Commission will schedule a technical conference to facilitate this process and direct its telecommunications department to coordinate these efforts. The parties are directed to prepare proposed uniform customer notices for submission to the Commission for approval.

¹ Alltel Missouri, Inc. includes Cass County Telephone Company, Craw-Kan Telephone Cooperative, Inc., Fidelity Telephone Company, Bourbeuse Telephone Company, New Florence Telephone Company, New London Telephone Company, and Stoutland Telephone Company.
