On October 3, 2012, the Commission issued a report and order granting Laclede Gas Company's application to establish a depreciation rate for its new Enterprise Computer Software System. That report and order became effective on October 13. On October 11, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a timely application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, Public Counsel has not shown sufficient reason to rehear the report and order. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Office of the Public Counsel's Application for Rehearing is denied.
