2	JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Good morning.
3	Today is Tuesday, January 26, 2010. We are here for a
4	prehearing conference in the matter of Atmos Energy
5	Corporation's tariff revision designed to implement a
6	general rate increase for natural gas service in the
7	Missouri service area of the company, which is File
8	No. GR-2010-0192.
9	My name is Harold Stearley. I'm the
10	presiding officer over this matter. And our court
11	reporter this morning is Kellene Feddersen. We'll begin
12	by taking entries of appearance, starting with Atmos
13	Energy Corporation.
14	MR. FISCHER: Thank you, Judge. Let the
15	record reflect the appearance of Larry W. Dority and Jim
16	Fischer appearing today on behalf of Atmos Energy
17	Corporation. Our address is 101 Madison Street,
18	Suite 400, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101.
19	JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank your, Mr. Fischer.
20	Noranda Aluminum, Incorporated. Ms. Vuylsteke, are you
21	still with us?
22	MS. VUYLSTEKE: Yes, I am, Judge. Diana
23	Vuylsteke from the law firm Bryan Cave, LLP, appearing for
24	Noranda Aluminum. Our street address is 211 North
25	Broadway, Suite 3600, St. Louis, Missouri 63102.

1 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Ms. Vuylsteke. 2 Can you hear me all right on your end? 3 MS. VUYLSTEKE: I can. Thank you. 4 JUDGE STEARLEY: Missouri Department of 5 Natural Resources. б MS. MANGELSDORF: Sarah Mangelsdorf 7 appearing for the Missouri Department of Natural 8 Resources, P.O. Box 899, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. 9 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. Thank you. And the 10 Office of Public Counsel. 11 MR. POSTON: Marc Poston appearing for the Office of the Public Counsel and the public, P.O. Box 12 13 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. 14 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Poston. And the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission. 15 16 MR. BERLIN: Appearing on behalf of the 17 Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Robert S. Berlin, Samuel Ritchie and Jamie Ott, Post Office Box 360, 18 Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. 19 20 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Berlin. 21 Do we have any preliminary matters we need 22 to address at this time? Okay. Well, hearing none, a couple of quick things to go over with you-all 23 24 schedule-wise. I know I've got February 2nd set as a 25 deadline for the filing of a procedural schedule, for

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1 recommendations on test year and true-up, for

2 recommendations on local public hearings, and for filing a 3 proposed customer notice.

In addition to those items, when you file your procedural schedule, I would like you to place an item in there for the filing of a joint stipulation of non-contested material facts. It can probably coincide with the date for surrebuttal testimony.

9 And I know the Commission sent tentative 10 hearing dates, and usually we hear from the parties and we 11 adjust those to accommodate you, but I have since acquired 12 a couple conflict dates myself for that first week in July 13 that I had named in the Order, the 12th through the 16th. 14 I will be unavailable the 13th, 15th and 16th.

15 So in putting your schedule together, I 16 don't know if you want to push the evidentiary hearing to 17 start on the following week or how you-all may want to 18 adjust that.

MR. BERLIN: Judge, if I may make a comment on that?

21 JUDGE STEARLEY: Certainly.

22 MR. BERLIN: One of the things we're going 23 to talk about with regard to the procedural schedule, of 24 course, is the date of the hearing. I'd like to also note 25 that Staff is constrained from a staffing standpoint

1 because of ongoing rate cases. So I would anticipate that 2 that date would be moved back. 3 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Very good. 4 MR. BERLIN: Perhaps into August. 5 JUDGE STEARLEY: Well, we'll see how far б the Commission is willing to let you go back. Do you 7 think Staff is going to have to request obtaining any 8 outside resources? 9 MR. BERLIN: At this time, I understand that Staff is pursuing that option. 10 11 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Very good. Well, I will wait for your proposed procedural schedule, 12 13 and maybe we'll accommodate all our potential conflicts. I've brought a couple copies of our adjudication calendar. 14 15 I don't know if you have any with you or not, but this may 16 aid you in picking your dates. 17 MR. FISCHER: Judge, I also might mention 18 that I noticed in the procedural order there was some 19 confusion or uncertainty about the test year that the 20 company was proposing, and that others were to respond to 21 that on February 2nd. I thought it might be helpful if 22 the company filed a clearer pleading that clearly 23 identified the test year and update period. I was 24 planning to do that probably later today. 25 JUDGE STEARLEY: That would be fine,

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Mr. Fischer, and I'm sure greatly appreciated. We'll all know our starting point. Is there anything else that we need to address this morning for the on-the-record portion of this conference? (No response.) б JUDGE STEARLEY: Hearing nothing further, we will adjourn the on-the-record portion and I'll leave you all to your discussions. Thank you all very much. WHEREUPON, the recorded portion of the prehearing conference was concluded.
