## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PLEADING STATING WHEN IT WILL FILE A RECOMMENDATION

On October 22, 2015, Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. ("Company") filed an application seeking authority from the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to amend its existing credit agreement and to issue up to and including an aggregate of \$100,000,000 of long-term indebtedness. The Company has requested expedited treatment of this matter and Commission action by December 19, 2015. The Commission will need a recommendation from its Staff before acting on the Company's application. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to respond indicating when it will be able to file a recommendation in this matter.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than October 30, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a pleading stating when it anticipates filing its recommendation in this matter.

2. This order shall become effective when issued.
