STAFF'S AMENDED RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE TARIFF FILING ON AN EXPEDITED BASIS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and, files its Amended Recommendation to approve this Request for Waiver of Tariff Provisions Related to Revised Actual Cost Adjustment factors. In support thereof Staff states:

- 1. Atmos filed a tariff change to implement an energy efficiency program and to amend its existing program.
 - 2. In addition, Atmos filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment.
- 3. Atmos filed the tariff sheets to introduce *Energize Atmos Energy Homes* as an addition to its Energy Conservation and Efficiency Program. This new program is designed to address building shell measures (e.g., insulation and air infiltration measures) and to provide tiered rebates for certain appliances.
- 4. This program also satisfies the requirements of the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement for Case No. GR-2010-0192. (Paragraph 12 e, page 7.)
- 5. Staff has changed the description of the involvement of the Atmos Energy Efficiency Advisory Group to reflect the role of the Group as advisory.

WHEREFORE based on the reasons stated in the attached Staff Recommendation, Staff recommends Commission approval of the tariff revisions on an expedited basis.
