AMENDED STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its amended recommendation states:

- 1. In its Staff Recommendation filed March 27, 2000, in this case, Staff recommended the Commission grant to FairPoint Communications Corp. a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services, classify the company and its services as competitive, and approve the waivers listed in the notice of applications. Subsequent to filing of its foregoing recommendation, Staff learned that tariff sheets 42-48 it had reviewed and relied upon in making its recommendation were not filed in this case before the Commission. In response to a discussion between counsel for Staff and counsel for Applicant, Applicant, on April 6, 2000 voluntarily extended the effective date of the filed tariff for thirty (30) days, filed the omitted tariff sheets 42-48 with an effective date of May 6, 2000, and requested expedited treatment.
- 2. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant FairPoint Communications Corp. (Applicant) a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications

services. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. (See §§ 392.430 and 392.440, RSMo 1994). Although Staff recommends in Appendix A that the certificate be made effective on the same date the full tariff would be effective—May 6, 2000, Staff has no objection to the Commission granting the Applicant's request for expedited treatment and making the tariff and certificate effective at some earlier date should the Commission determine doing so would be appropriate in these circumstances.

- 2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. (See §392.361.2 RSMo 1994). All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See §392.361.3 RSMo 1994).
- 3. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Application. The Staff notes that 4 CSR 240-32.030(1)(B) and 4 CSR 240-32.030(1)(C) are now found at 4 CSR 240-32.030(4)(C) and 4 CSR 240-32.030(4)(A)2, respectively. These waivers have been granted to other carriers in the past. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392 RSMo. (See §§ 392.361.3 and 392.420 RSMo 1994 and § 392.185 RSMo Supp. 1999).

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission grant FairPoint Communications Corp. a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services and a certificate to provide local exchange telecommunications services restricted to dedicated, private line local services, grant Applicant and its services competitive classification, grant Applicant's

request for expedited treatment, approve Applicant's proposed tariff, PSC MO No. 1, pages 1-48, with an appropriate effective date, and approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Applications with the modification of the references to 4 CSR 240-32.030(1)(B) and 4 CSR 240-32.030(1)(C) to 4 CSR 240-32.030(4)(C) and 4 CSR 240-32.030(4)(A)2, respectively.

On February 22, 2000, FairPoint Communications Corp. (FairPoint) filed an application for a Certificate of Service Authority to provide Interexchange and Local Exchange Telecommunications Service before the Missouri Public Service Commission. FairPoint filed a tariff as an exhibit with the application. During Staff's evaluation of that tariff, it became evident that pages were omitted. On March 16, 2000, a supplemental application was filed before the Commission. Also, upon Staff's request, the missing tariff pages were submitted but not properly filed as required by law. On March 23, 2000, at Staff's request, a substitute sheet was filed. Staff, unaware of the improper filing of the omitted pages, reviewed the tariff, in its entirety, found no objections, and circulated the application and tariff for review. On April 6, 2000, FairPoint correctly filed the 'omitted' pages to the tariff and extended the effective date of the tariff to May 6, 2000. Staff has reviewed the tariff and has no objections to its taking effect.
