## ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

Issue Date: December 17, 2014 Effective Date: December 17, 2014

On November 12, 2014, the Commission issued an order denying Heartland Midwest, LLC's motion that asked the Commission to authorize three Commission Staff members to disclose information provided to them during the course of their investigation into a natural gas explosion in Kansas City. On November 21, Heartland Midwest filed a timely application for rehearing. Missouri Gas Energy opposed that request for rehearing in a filing made on December 1. Heartland Midwest responded to Missouri Gas Energy's opposition on December 11.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." Heartland Midwest has not shown sufficient reason to rehear the order. The Commission will deny its application for rehearing.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Heartland Midwest, LLC's Application for Rehearing is denied.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
