ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO CONTINUE INVESTIGATION

Issue Date: June 26, 2013 Effective Date: June 26, 2013

On February 27, 2013, the Commission directed its Staff to investigate a natural gas explosion that occurred on February 19, 2013 in Kansas City, Missouri. The Commission asked Staff to provide periodic updates during the course of its investigation and to file either a Gas Incident Report or a Status Report regarding its investigation no later than June 27, 2013. Staff filed a Status Report on June 18.

Staff explains that it continues to investigate the cause of the explosion. Once that investigation is complete, Staff will file a Gas Incident Report to explain in detail the facts of the explosion and Staff's analysis, conclusions and recommendations. Staff indicates it will file its next Status Report no later than July 26, 2013.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

Staff shall continue to investigate the gas safety incident and shall file a Status
Report regarding its investigation no later than July 26, 2013.

2. This order shall be effective upon issuance.
