#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

- 1. On March 16, 2009, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed an application with the Commission for approval of an interconnection agreement with Commnet Midwest, LLC and approval for an amendment to the interconnection agreement under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 2. Section 252(e) of the Act provides that a State commission may only reject a negotiated agreement (or any portion thereof) if it finds that the agreement (or any portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if the implementation of the agreement (or portion) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)
- 3. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff states that the interconnection agreement and amendment do not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the agreement and are not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve the interconnection agreement and amendment pursuant to the Act, and direct the parties to submit any further modifications or amendments.
