ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND MAKING AT&T MOBILITY A PARTY

Syllabus: This order provides notice of this application to interested parties.

establishes a deadline for intervention and for requesting a hearing, and joins the other

party to the interconnection agreement, New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC and its Operating

Affiliates, d/b/a AT&T Mobility ("AT&T Mobility"), as a party to this proceeding.

On August 16, 2012, the Companies¹ filed applications with the Commission for

approval of a negotiated traffic termination agreement with AT&T Mobility under the

provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. The Companies state that there

are no unresolved issues and that the agreement complies with Section 252(e) of the Act in

that it is consistent with public interest, convenience and necessity, and not discriminatory

to nonparty carriers

Although AT&T Mobility is a party to the agreements, it did not join in the

applications. Because AT&T Mobility is a necessary party to a full and fair adjudication of

this matter, the Commission will add AT&T Mobility as a party to this case.

The Act provides that an interconnection or resale agreement must be approved

unless the state commission finds that the agreement discriminates against a

telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement, or that implementation of the

agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.²

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Section 252(e)(4) of the Act provides that if the Commission has not approved an agreement within 90 days after submission, the agreement shall be deemed approved. The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 15 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing. The Commission also finds that notice of this application shall be sent to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The Commission's Data Center shall send notice to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.
- 2. New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC and its Operating Affiliates, d/b/a AT&T Mobility is made a party to this case.
- 3. Any party wishing to intervene or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than August 31, 2012, with:
