**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO AT&T'S OPPOSITION AND
RESPONSE TO APPLICATION TO INTERVENE**

On February 20, 2014, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri applied to the Commission for approval of an amendment to an interconnection agreement with AT&T Corp. On March 10, tw telecom of kansas city llc applied to intervene, indicating its concern that the proposed amendment may discriminate against telecommunications carriers that are not parties to the agreement. AT&T filed a response to tw telecom's application to intervene on March 19. AT&T opposes tw telecom's intervention and denies that the proposed amendment is discriminatory.

Before acting on tw telecom's application to intervene, the Commission will establish a time for tw telecom and other parties to reply to AT&T's response.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to reply to AT&T's Opposition and Response to Application to Intervene shall do so no later than March 27, 2014.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
