ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

On April 18, 2016, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Charter Fiberlink-Missouri LLC's ("Charter Fiberlink") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariffs to provide basic local and interexchange telecommunication services in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted Charter Fiberlink a certificate of service authority to provide basic local and interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number TA-2001-346.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
