**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, on its own behalf and on behalf of Missouri-American Water Company, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Platte County Regional Sewer District, being all of the parties in this case, and, for its Motion for Extension of Time to File Proposed Procedural Schedule, states to the Missouri Public Service Commission as follows.

On May 15, 2007, the Commission issued an order scheduling a procedural conference of all of the parties for May 30, 2007. In the same order, the Commission ordered the parties to jointly or separately file a proposed procedural schedule no later than June 6, 2007.

The parties appeared at the prehearing conference on May 15 and discussed the issues in the case. As a result of this prehearing conference, important new information was provided that may have a significant bearing on the procedure to follow in this case, or even whether the case should proceed at all. The said information has not been verified, however, and the parties believe that they need to verify this information before they can determine what procedure should be followed and whether the case should proceed at all.

The parties therefore request an extension of the time by which they must file a proposed procedural schedule, in order to enable them to complete the necessary investigation. The parties believe that ten days will be a sufficient amount of time to verify this information, and they request that the deadline for filing the proposed procedural schedule be extended to June 15, 2007.

WHEREFORE, the parties move the Commission for its order extending the deadline for filing a proposed procedural schedule to June 15, 2007.
