- 2 JUDGE REED: All right. This is the
- 3 case styled Manager of the Manufactured Housing
- 4 and Modular Units Program of the Public Service
- 5 Commission versus Four Seasons Manufacturing, Inc.
- 6 d/b/a Four Seasons Housing, Case No. MC-2006-0388.
- 7 My name is Steve Reed. I'm the
- 8 Regulatory Law Judge assigned to preside over this
- 9 case. We're here this morning for a prehearing
- 10 conference.
- 11 After the portion on the record, I'll
- 12 ask the parties to try to reach a proposed procedural
- 13 schedule which I'll ask the staff to file by the end
- 14 of next week, if possible.
- 15 Let's have appearances first by the
- 16 staff.
- 17 MR. BERLIN: Robert S. Berlin, Post

- JUDGE REED: I don't see anyone. I note

- 8 It's a complaint case against Blakely
