ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFFS

Issue Date: October 9, 2007 Effective Date: October 19, 2007

On August 7, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariffs of Pac-West Telecomm, Inc., a company that has been authorized to offer basic local and interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services by the Commission.

In Case Number LA-2006-0155, the Commission granted Pac-West a certificate to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services. In the same case, Pac-West's tariff, PSC MO No. 1, was also approved.

Also in Case Number LA-2006-0155, the Commission granted Pac-West a certificate to provide basic local telecommunications services. In the same case, Pac-West's tariff, PSC MO No. 2, was also approved.

Staff's motion states that on May 11, 2007, the Commission received a bankruptcy notice from Pac-West informing the Commission of their April 30, 2007 petitions with the United States Bankruptcy Court to reorganize under Chapter 11.

By letter dated July 24, 2007, the Vice President of Pac-West notified the Commission of Pac-West's intent to discontinue all telecommunications services as part of the company's bankruptcy reorganization. The letter indicated the anticipated date for discontinuance of service would be approximately August 23, 2007.

Staff's motion indicates that in the company's most recent Annual Report, no access lines were reported. Pac-West has no past due annual reports or assessments due to the Commission. No formal complaints have been filed against the company since the commencement of the Electronic Filing and Information System. In addition, Pac-West is listed as being in good standing according to the Missouri Secretary of State's Office.

Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide basic local and intrastate interexchange telecommunications services.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Pac-West's request, Staff's motion, and because Pac-West is not providing telecommunications service in Missouri, the Commission finds that the

certificate of service authority granted to Pac-West Telecomm, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The certificate of authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services granted to Pac-West Telecomm, Inc., in Case Number LA-2006-0155, is canceled.
- 2. Pac-West's tariff, PSC MO No. 1, also granted in Case Number LA-2006-0155, is canceled.
- 3. The certificate of authority to provide basic local telecommunications services granted to Pac-West Telecomm, Inc., in Case Number LA-2006-0155, is canceled.
- 4. Pac-West's tariff, PSC MO No. 2, also granted in Case Number LA-2006-0155, is canceled.
 - 5. This order shall become effective on October 19, 2007.
 - 6. This case may be closed on October 20, 2007.
