**MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATES OF SERVICE AUTHORITY**

**COMES NOW** Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to cancel the certificates of service authority and tariffs of Everycall Communications, Inc. d/b/a American Home Phone (“American Home Phone”). For its Motion, Staff states as follows:

1. On June 7, 2010, the Commission granted American Home Phone certificates of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services and interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, and approved the associated tariffs in Case No. TA-2010-0293.

2. In March 28, 2013, Staff received American Home Phone’s Statement of Revenue for calendar year 2012, in which it states it no longer wishes to retain the certificates of service authority. (See Highly Confidential Attachment A).

3. Because American Home Phone requested cancellation of its certificates and it is not providing services in Missouri to the best of Staff’s knowledge, information and belief, Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the certificates and associated tariffs.

4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo 2000, which provides “Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

5. The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D. 1989).

6. American Home Phone is current on the payment of fiscal year assessments and submission of annual reports.

7. Staff is not aware of any other matter that the Commission’s decision in this case will affect, or be affected by.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the certificates of service authority and associated tariffs of EveryCall Communications, Inc. d/b/a All American Home Phone to provide basic local telecommunications services and interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.
