SECOND NOTICE REGARDING APPEARANCE BY TELEPHONE

Issue Date: February 16, 2006

An on-the-record proceeding to consider the stipulation and agreement that has been filed in this case is scheduled for February 17, 2006, beginning at 10:30 a.m. The Commission established a conference call bridge through the State Operator to permit any witness that does not wish to attend this proceeding in person to participate by telephone. Because of concerns about the disclosure of confidential information on a publicly disclosed conference bridge during the course of the proceeding, Sprint Nextel would prefer to have its witnesses appear via a conference call bridge arranged by Sprint Nextel.

Since the only witnesses that wish to participate by phone are the witnesses of Sprint Nextel, no other party has an interest in the mechanics of how the conference call is arranged. Therefore, the conference call bridge arranged through the State Operator has

been canceled. The Sprint Nextel witnesses that wish to participate by telephone may do so through the conference call bridge arranged by Sprint Nextel.
