## ORDER INDEFINITELY STAYING FILING DEADLINE

Issue Date: September 13, 2011 Effective Date: September 13, 2011

On September 12, 2011, Staff advised the Commission that a motion is pending before the bankruptcy court that could be dispositive on the question as to whether these matters are subject to that court's automatic stay. Consequently, Staff requests the deadline for filing a legal analysis as to the applicability of the automatic stay be delayed to allow the federal court to render its decision. The Commission finds the request to be reasonable and will grant it.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The September 12, 2011 deadline for filing a legal analysis of Halo Wireless, Inc.'s suggestions of bankruptcy is indefinitely stayed.

- 2. The Commission's Staff shall notify the Commission when the bankruptcy court issues its decision on the "Motion of the AT&T Companies to Determine Automatic Stay Inapplicable and for Relief from Automatic Stay."
  - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
