ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 6, 2008, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a "CenturyTel" (collectively, "CenturyTel") and Socket Telecom, LLC ("Socket") filed a Joint Motion by Consent of CenturyTel and Socket to Suspend the Procedural Schedule Pending the Commission's Ruling on their Motions for Summary Determination. In support of their joint motion, CenturyTel and Socket state that the Commission's ruling on their pending motions for summary determination may obviate the need for the filing of written testimony and an evidentiary hearing. To avoid having the parties incur significant expenditures of time and resources preparing testimony and preparing for the evidentiary hearing when such efforts may be unnecessary, CenturyTel and Socket ask the Commission to suspend the current procedural schedule until such time as it reaches a decision concerning the motions for summary determination.

CenturyTel and Socket further state that the other parties to this case, the Commission's Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel, do not object to their joint motion. The Commission finds CenturyTel and Socket's joint motion to be reasonable and shall grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The procedural schedule currently in place in this case is suspended.
2. This order shall become effective on March 7, 2008.
