## SECOND AMENDMENT BY INTERLINEATION TO APPLICATION TO EXPAND CERTIFICATE OF BASIC LOCAL SERVICE AUTHORITY

Comes now Metropolitan Telecommunications of Missouri, Inc. and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(14) hereby files this amendment by interlineation to its Application to Expand Certificate of Basic Local Service Authority (the Application) in the captioned matter to reflect a correction in the requested waivers. Its application is amended as set forth below:

- 1. Paragraph 13 of the Application is amended to read as follows:
- 13. Applicant intends to offer its services in accord with its tariffs. Pursuant to the provisions of 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(C) the filing of a proposed tariff with this application is optional. Because negotiations are not final with Windstream Missouri, Inc., the charges for interconnection and network elements, and other material provisions and terms have not been concluded. Applicant requests the Commission to afford it the option of deferring the filing of its proposed tariffs. Applicant intends to supply its proposed tariffs to the Commission with at least a thirty-day effective date at the time its interconnection agreement is approved.
- 2. Except as set forth above and in Applicant's Amendment by Interlineation filed with the Commission on August 23, 2013, the remainder of the Application is unaltered by this amendment and is hereby realleged and restated herein.

WHEREFORE, Metropolitan Telecommunications of Missouri, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission grant it an expanded certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service as herein requested, classify Applicant and Applicant's proposed basic local services as competitive, and grant waivers of aforesaid statutes and regulations.
