ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On May 12, 2011, Zayo Fiber Solutions, LLC ("Zayo") filed an application requesting its certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide non-switched local exchange and interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted AGL Networks, LLC a certificate of service authority to provide non-switched local exchange and interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number CA-2008-0306. In File Number XN-2011-0026, the Commission granted the amendment to the certificate of service authority to reflect a name change to Zayo.

On May 12, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a response to Zayo's application. Staff stated they had no objection to Zayo's request to cancel the certificate of service authority and any accompanying tariff.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no

request for a hearing or objection to Zayo's application is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Zayo's application and Staff's response.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to file an objection or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than May 26, 2011, with:
