Charter Fiberlink - Missouri, LLC and Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri), LLC (collectively, the "Charter Entities") submitted a Joint Application in the above captioned docket on January 6, 2021.

At the time of the submission of the Joint Application, the Charter Entities requested confidential treatment of Exhibit H. This letter is to inform the Commission that it is no longer necessary to treat Exhibit H as confidential.

Exhibit H included an explanation that Charter intended to commit at least an additional \$200 million of its own capital to supplement the \$48.4 million in RDOF funds awarded for Missouri. The information in Exhibit H has now been made publicly available. Accordingly, the Charter Entities no longer require Exhibit H to be treated as confidential by the Commission.
