On November 15, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation and accompanying rebuttal testimony regarding the application of Sprint Nextel Corporation to transfer control of Sprint Missouri, Inc.; Sprint Long Distance, Inc.; and Sprint Payphone Services, Inc., to LTD Holding Company, a new holding company that is being spun off from Sprint Nextel. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the proposed transaction subject to certain conditions.

In order to move this matter forward, the Commission will establish a date for the other parties to file a response to Staff's recommendation.

1. That any party that wants to file a response to Staff's Recommendation shall do so not later than December 6, 2005.
