



## **Initial Arbitration Meeting**

The federal Telecommunications Act requires that this arbitration be completed by January 23, 2008. Due to the short amount of time available for this arbitration, the Arbitrator will promptly schedule an initial arbitration meeting. At this meeting, the parties will be expected to consider and propose a procedural schedule that will allow this arbitration to proceed in the time allowed by statute. If any of the parties desire to appear at the initial meeting by telephone, they shall notify the Arbitrator as directed below.

1. The Data Center shall serve notice of this petition upon Leap Wireless, International, Inc., and Cricket Communications, Inc.

2. Leap Wireless, International, Inc., and Cricket Communications, Inc., are made parties to this case.

3. Leap Wireless, International, Inc., and Cricket Communications, Inc., shall file a joint response or separate responses, and any additional information regarding the petition for arbitration, no later than October 22, 2007, with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, with a copy to:
