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The Commission is granting the Joint Motion for Leave to File Conformed

Interconnection Agreement and Parties' Statements by December 29 ("motion").

On December 16, 2010, the parties jointly filed the motion. In the motion, the parties

seek an extension of the time to meet the following requirement:

. . . the parties shall file with the commission the entire agreement that was the subject of the negotiation [to] conform in all respects to the commission's order [; with] statements that indicate whether the agreement complies with the requirements of sections 251 and 252 of the Act, Missouri statutes, and the commission's rules.[¹]

That filing is due:

. . . within seven (7) days of the filing of a commission order approving, rejecting or modifying the arbitrator's final report $[,^2]$

which occurred on December 15, 2010, making the filing due on December 22, 2010.

But that time limit only applies "Unless the commission orders otherwise [.³]" In support of an order extending the time, the parties cite the press of business and the parties' need to accommodate their employees' holiday schedules. The Commission is mindful that such factors arise despite the conscientious efforts of all parties. The parties also note the joint nature of the motion and the absence of prejudice to any party. Therefore, the Commission will grant motion and extend the time for filing the conformed agreement and statements.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Joint Motion for Leave to File Conformed Interconnection Agreement and Parties' Statements by December 29 is granted.

2. The parties shall file the documents described at 4 CSR 240-36.050(1) no later than December 29, 2010.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
