On May 1, 2008, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, filed a Motion for Extension of Briefing Schedule requesting an additional two weeks, or until June 11th, for the parties to prepare and file their post hearing briefs. In its motion, CenturyTel stated that the Commission's Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel concur in its request. CenturyTel further advised the Commission that Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC, may oppose its request. Because the current due date for briefs is just over three weeks away, the Commission shall shorten the time for filing objections to CenturyTel's motion.
