ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

On August 10, 2022, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange, non-switched local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services granted to Call One, Inc. (Company). On February 25, 2011, the Commission granted the certificate of service authority at issue to United Communications Systems, Inc. d/b/a Call One in File No. LA-2011-0230. In File No. LN-2012-0371, the Company's name change to Call One, Inc. was recognized by the Commission. The Staff's motion states that the Company wishes to voluntarily relinquish its authority. The Company has two applicable tariffs that it also requested be cancelled – YL-2012-0564 and YL-2012-0565.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed ten days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
