Based on references to Western Communications, Inc. dba Logix Communications ("WCI") in the Supplement To Motion To Open Case and Cancel Certification of Service Authority and Accompanying Tariff, WCI provides the following information.

WCI has not acquired or merged with American Telco, Inc. ("ATI") or Logix Communications, Inc. ("LCC"). Instead, WCI purchased the assets of LCC through the bankruptcy court. It is also WCI's understanding the LCC was the successor corporation for ATI.

As a result, it is correct that no record evidencing WCI's acquisition/merger with ATI exists since such action did not take place. Instead, as the motion states, the Commission did approve the transfer of assets and subscribers from LCC to ATI. Similarly, WCI has no interest in the ATI certificate of service authority and no objection to its cancellation by the Commission.
