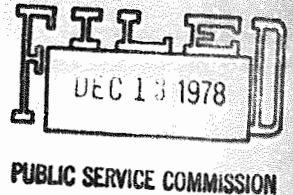


APPLICATION FOR A CONTINUANCE
