ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On April 27, 2012¹, Laclede filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2010, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for numerous gas utility plant projects. The Commission issued notice of the application on April 30, giving potential intervenors until May 21 to request intervention. USW Local 11-6 (hereafter "Local 11-6") applied for intervention on May 15.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) gives parties ten days to respond to pleadings. Laclede did not respond to Local 11-6's application. Therefore, the Commission will take up the application unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) provides that the Commission may permit any person to intervene on a showing that the proposed intervenor has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case; or granting the proposed intervention would serve

the public interest. Local 11-6 pleads that as a collective bargaining representative of certain Laclede employees, it has an interest different from that of the general public.

The Commission will grant the application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Verified Application of USW Local 11-6 to Intervene is granted.
- 2. This order shall become effective immediately on issuance.
