1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 JUDGE VOSS: Good afternoon. We're here
3 for a prehearing conference in Commission Case No.
4 LC-2008-0049, in the matter of the complaint of Charter
5 Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC seeking expedited resolution and
6 enforcement of interconnection agreement terms between
7 Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC and CenturyTel of
8 Missouri, LLC.

9 My name is Cherlyn Voss. I'm the
10 Regulatory Law Judge assigned to hear this case, and I'll
11 be presiding over this prehearing conference. We're going
12 to begin with entries of appearance, beginning with
13 Charter Fiberlink-Missouri.

14 MR. COMLEY: Thank you, Judge Voss. Let
15 the record reflect the entry of appearance of Mark W.
16 Comley, Newman, Comley & Ruth, 601 Monroe Street,
17 Suite 301, Jefferson City, Missouri.

18 And also let me introduce Carrie L. Cox who
19 is sitting to my right, along with Lawrence G. Christopher
20 and Clifford K. Williams. They have business address of
21 12405 Powers Court Drive, St. Louis, Missouri. Also --
22 and Clifford Williams is on the phone today, but also on
23 the phone is Mr. K.C. Halm of Davis Wright Tremaine, 1919
24 Pennsylvania Avenue NW, Suite 200, Washington, D.C. 2006
25 (sic) is the zip code. And to the extent that they will

1 be appearing, motions for pro hoc vice will be filed
2 shortly. I wanted them to be introduced to the
3 Commission. We're all appearing on behalf of Charter
4 Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC.

5 JUDGE VOSS: CenturyTel of Missouri?

6 MR. DORITY: Well, Judge, we're clearly
7 outnumbered this afternoon, but let the record reflect on
8 behalf of CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, Larry W. DORITY
9 with Fischer & DORITY, PC. Our address is 101 Madison,
10 Suite 400, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101.

11 And also participating by telephone is
12 Tyler Peters and Christopher J. Sherman with Payne and
13 Jones, Chartered. Their address is 11000 King, P.O.
14 Box 25625, Overland Park, Kansas 66210. And written
15 entries of appearance have been provided to the court
16 reporter.

17 JUDGE VOSS: Thank you. The Commission
18 Staff?

19 MR. BAKER: Blane Baker on behalf of the
20 Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, P.O.
21 Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.

22 JUDGE VOSS: The office of the Public
23 Counsel?

24 MR. DANDINO: Thank you, your Honor.
25 Michael Dandino, Office of the Public Counsel, Post Office

1 Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, representing the
2 Office of the Public Counsel and the public.

3 JUDGE VOSS: Thank you. The primary
4 purpose of the prehearing is to get the parties together
5 and discuss any discovery issues, any possibilities of
6 settlement and, if necessary, to work out a procedural
7 schedule.

8 To that effect, the order that scheduled
9 this prehearing conference originally set November 14th as
10 a deadline to file a proposed procedural schedule. With
11 the number of parties involved and other cases going on,
12 if there is a conflict and you need additional time, I
13 would entertain a motion for additional time.

14 And basically, is there anything else that
15 I need to address before going off the record?

16 MR. DORITY: I don't think so, Judge.

17 JUDGE VOSS: Hearing none -- actually, one
18 question first. Do you guys have a copy of the Commission
19 calendar? Do you want me to go up and grab one? I meant
20 to bring one down and I didn't.

21 MR. COMLEY: I think that would be helpful.

22 JUDGE VOSS: I'll bring one down. All
23 right. Hearing nothing else, we will conclude the
24 on-the-record portion of the prehearing conference and
25 I'll be back shortly with the calendar.
