COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Service Commission, and for its recommendation in this matter, states:

1. The Commission granted Pac-West Telecomm, Inc., a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange, telecommunications services; non-switched local exchange telecommunications services, restricted to dedicated, private line services; and basic local telecommunications services in the State of Missouri. The Commission granted this authority in Case No. LA-2006-0155 on December 29, 2005. In its Order, in keeping with Commission statutes and regulations, the Commission directed that "Pac-West Telecomm, Inc. shall not conduct business in Missouri until the Commission approves its tariff and interconnection agreements."

2. Pac-West Telecomm, Inc. has now submitted tariffs for the Commission's approval to set forth the terms and conditions of the services it proposes to provide.

3. In the attached Memorandum, labeled Appendix A, the Staff indicates that it has no objection to the tariffs, P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1 and P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 2, taking effect.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission approve the tariffs filed by Pac-West Telecomm, Inc., P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1 and P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 2.
