STATUS REPORT

COME NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) (collectively the “Company”) and, pursuant to the Missouri Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) *Order Granting Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule* issued in this docket on January 28, 2019, state as follows:

1. The Company, Commission Staff (“Staff”), the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”), Midwest Energy Consumers Group, (“MECG”), National Housing Trust (“NHT”), Westside Housing Organization (“WHO”), Spire Missouri, Inc. (“Spire”), Natural Resources Defense Council (“NRDC”), the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy (“DE”), City of St. Joseph, Missouri (“City of St. Joe”) and Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri (“Renew MO”) (collectively, the “Parties”) have engaged in constructive ongoing settlement discussions and have reached settlement of a MEEIA 2 extension in principle, with all parties indicating their willingness to either sign or not oppose the settlement. However, the parties need additional time to finalize the exhibits to the settlement agreement.

WHEREFORE, the Company respectfully submits this status report and request that the Commission allow an additional 1 day, to and including Thursday, February 14, 2019, for the filing of a stipulation.
