RESPONSE TO ORDER DIRECTING CLARIFICATION OF APPLICATION

Comes now Applicant Time Warner Entertainment -- Advance/Newhouse Partnership, by its undersigned counsel, and in response to the Commission's July 28 Order Directing Clarification of Application ("the Order"), states the following:

1. In the Order, the Commission notes that it appears that the Applicant is a fictitious name for an unnamed parent company. As this Response demonstrates, that is not the case. The Applicant believes that this Response will clarify the situation to the Commission's satisfaction.

2. On February 24, 2009, the Commission issued its Notice Closing Case in Case No. KA-2009-0282, acknowledging the name change of KCCP Trust to Time Warner Entertainment -- Advance/Newhouse Partnership (i.e., the Applicant herein), and that the Applicant continued to possess the state-issued video franchises which KCCP Trust had previously obtained. *See* copy of February 24 Order, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

3. On January 6, 2009, Time Warner Entertainment -- Advance Newhouse Partnership filed a Registration of Fictitious Name with the Missouri Secretary of State. The fictitious name which was registered is "Time Warner Cable." The Registration is currently effective, and will continue to be effective through January 6, 2014. *See* copy of Registration of Fictitious Name, attached hereto as Exhibit B.

4. Thus, the Applicant is a legitimate entity, not a dba, and it has properly registered the use of the fictitious name Time Warner Cable. The Applicant believes that this should clear up the issues, but it stands ready to respond to Commission questions.

Wherefore, the Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission approve its Application.
