## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On June 4, 2013, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Everycall Communications, Inc., d/b/a All American Home Phone (“Everycall”) certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide basic local telecommunications services and interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted Everycall a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services and interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number TA-2010-0293.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff’s motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff’s motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.


1. Any party wishing to file an objection or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than June 17, 2013, with:
