**RESPONSE OF MISSOURI-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY
TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC), by and through its attorneys, and files this Response to Staff Recommendation. In support of said response, MAWC states as follows:

1. On September 21, 2007, Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Recommendation concerning MAWC's application. As part of its filing, Staff recommended that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issue an order granting MAWC's request for a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide water and sewer service to the modified proposed service area, as shown in Attachment 1 and as described in Attachment 2. In addition, Staff recommended that the Commission require MAWC to submit new tariff sheets for its Incline Village water and sewer tariffs, and to include a map and written description of the revised service area in each.

2. MAWC has reviewed the above reference Staff filing and does not object to its recommendations to the Commission

WHEREFORE, MAWC respectfully submits that it has no objections to the Staff Recommendation.
