**NOTICE REGARDING APPEARANCE PRO HAC VICE**

On September 16, 2005, Ricardo Alberto Garcia, a member of the Texas Bar but not a member of the Missouri Bar, filed a request to intervene on behalf of the Communications Workers of America. The request to intervene designates a member of the Missouri Bar, Arthur J. Martin, as local counsel.

Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m) provides that any non-Missouri attorney wishing to appear in a particular case in any court or administrative tribunal in this state must first pay a fee of \$100 to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for each case in which he or she seeks to appear. The rule further provides that any request to appear in any court or administrative tribunal in this state must be accompanied by a receipt indicating that the \$100 fee has been paid (Rule 9.03).

Mr. Garcia has not complied with the Supreme Court's rules and the Commission cannot permit him to appear in this case unless he first complies with those rules.
