**STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT AMENDMENT REGARDING
AMEREN MISSOURI'S KEEPING CURRENT PROGRAM**

As a result of discussions among the parties, Ameren Missouri, AARP, the Consumers Council of Missouri, the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel (collectively "the Signatories") have determined that additional time is needed in order to file a new Keeping Current program tariff. The Signatories hereby submit to the Commission this *Stipulation and Agreement Amendment Regarding Ameren Missouri's Keeping Current Program* ("*Stipulation Amendment*"), which requests an extension of the date previously agreed upon in the *Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Ameren Missouri's Keeping Current Program* ("*Stipulation*").

1. On September 24, 2012, certain parties filed a *Stipulation* regarding Ameren Missouri's Keeping Current Program. The *Stipulation* required the parties to file a revised Keeping Current tariff so that it would be effective January 2, 2013.

2. On October 3, 2012, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order approving the *Stipulation*.

3. Since that date, the Signatories have been working together in order to develop the revised tariff, but due to scheduling and other considerations, that work is not complete and is likely to take more time than contemplated in the *Stipulation*. At this time, the Signatories do not contemplate problems with reaching an agreement on this matter.

4. The Signatories request that they be allowed until March 15, 2013, to have a revised tariff in effect.

5. The Signatories agree that this *Stipulation Amendment* does not change the obligation of Ameren Missouri to provide funding for this program. Additionally, this *Stipulation Amendment* is not intended to impact the start date of the Keeping Current surcharge on customer bills.

6. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Barnes-Jewish Hospital, the Missouri Energy Consumer Group, the Sierra Club, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri, the Natural Resources Defense Council, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Locals 2, 309, 649, 702, 1439, 1455 and the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 148, AFL-CIO have indicated that while they will not sign this Stipulation, they do not oppose it.

WHEREFORE, on this 12th day of December, 2012, the Signatories respectfully request the Commission to issue an Order in this case approving this *Stipulation and Agreement Amendment Regarding Ameren Missouri's Keeping Current Program*.
