## The Basics of ARC Participation in MISO

- An ARC contracts with end-use customers to offer their demand into the markets and registers in MISO as a Demand Response
  - ARC must verify that their regulator (Relevant Electric Retail Regulatory Authority) allows for ARC participation prior to registering with MISO
  - ARCs register Demand Response as different resource types, representing the capabilities of the asset. From capacity/emergency only (Load Modifying Resource-DR), to full energy and ancillary participation (DRR Type I, II)
- MISO verifies registration
- MISO notifies the registered customers' Load Serving Entity (LSE) and Local Balancing Authority (LBA) of the ARC registration
  - LSE & LBA have 10 business days for comments, feedback, approval or rejection
