On March 23, 2021, i3 Broadband, LLC (“the Company”) pursuant to Section 67.2679.7, RSMo 2016, filed an Application seeking to provide video service to the following political subdivisions:

Political Subdivision	Fee Amount
St. Charles (County)	5%
St. Charles (City)	5%
O’Fallon (City)	5%

The Commission has reviewed the application filed by the Company and finds that it and the attached affidavit comply with the filing requirements set forth in Section 67.2679.7, RSMo 2016.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. i3 Broadband, LLC is granted authority to provide video service in the franchise area of each political subdivision set forth in the application and restated above.
2. i3 Broadband, LLC is granted authority to construct a video service network along, across, or on public rights-of-way for the delivery of video service to the extent the video service provider or an affiliate did not otherwise possess a valid authorization to occupy the public rights-of-way.
3. This order shall become effective when issued, after which this file may be closed.
